What Should You Expect?

A change in prescription drug coverage can be unnerving. Know that we recognize how important prescription drug coverage is to everyone.

In the communications to come we will share information that will help to ensure a smooth transition for you and your family. A few of the themes we will cover are listed below:

- ◆ New ID cards will be released prior to July 1st—be on the lookout mid June.
- ◆ A new Customer Service phone number and website for assistance in managing your medications.
- ◆ New Mobile apps to help you manage your medications.
- ◆ A new list of covered medications under Capital Rx. The Capital Rx formulary (or a list of prescription drugs covered) and copayment tiers may be different than the current formulary. Learn the steps you may need to take to ensure your medications continue without interruption.
- ◆ A new Mail Order Home Delivery vendor will replace the former Express Scripts mail order pharmacy. Stay tuned for information on how to transfer your maintenance medications to the new vendor.
- ◆ A new Specialty drug Pharmacy will replace Accredo. Plan participants taking a specialty drug may be eligible to receive your medication at no cost if the drug maker features a copayment assistance option. This program is called RX Cap. More detailed instructions will be coming your way.

While July may seem far away, we will communicate often in the months leading up to annual enrollment to ensure you are ready come July 1st.
