



# One More Reminder!

## Our Prescription Drug Coverage is Moving to Capital Rx

Prescription drug coverage through Capital Rx begins July 1, 2023.

### Remember the four key changes



**1. New ID Cards:** Capital Rx will provide you with a new member ID card. Beginning July 1, 2023, please use your new Capital Rx ID card and dispose of your old prescription drug carrier's ID card.



**2. Formulary:** There are two formularies offered through Capital Rx: the Freedom Formulary (open) and the Liberty Formulary (closed). Please contact Human Resources to determine which Formulary your district utilizes. If a prescription drug you are currently taking will be excluded by Capital Rx, you will experience a 90-day grace period starting July 1, 2023, during which you will be able to continue to fill that drug.



**3. Mail order:** If you currently have a mail order prescription, Capital Rx will work directly with your current mail order pharmacy to transfer your prescription. Please note: only valid prescriptions with refills will be transferred. Refer to previous communications for more details.



**4. Capital Rx Mobile App:** Follow these steps to register.

1. Visit <https://app.cap-rx.com/register>
2. Fill in your personal information and click VALIDATE
3. Complete credentials form and click CREATE ACCOUNT
4. Check your email and locate the verification code sent from Capital Rx
5. Enter the code provided to validate your email address

Once you complete these steps, you can login using your new credentials.
